



### **Translucent Canopy Adds Exciting Aesthetic at Georgia's Moultrie Tech** continued...

The new 45,000-square-foot Allied Health facility houses classrooms and labs. “We positioned the building to be visible from the highway,” Evans says, “so aesthetic elements were important.” The canopy itself connects the facility to the plaza, tying the exterior design to the entire project.

“Frankly, I was concerned about how the polycarbonate would handle possible abuse,” says Evans, “but it’s pretty amazing. The benefit is that this is a solution that’s better all the way around. It’s lightweight and low maintenance.”

Actually, the multiwall polycarbonate has 200 times the impact strength of glass with only one-sixth the weight. It’s virtually shatterproof and is self-extinguishing. The glazing is used in healthcare facilities, educational campuses and commercial applications across the country.

Evans says Duo-Gard’s stock-length program also proved very cost effective. “This is a great solution for all kinds of applications,” he adds. “We’re all very pleased with the results.”
